# Doi Suthep Temple & Hmong Hill Tribe Village

📍 **A MUST SEE AND MOST POPULAR LANDMARK  
WHEN VISITING IN CHIANG MAI. ”**

**D**oi Suthep Temple is a place of worship dated back to 1383 when the first pagoda was built. It is an important pilgrimage spot for devotion and a sacred site to Thai and foreigners where visitors can climb up 309 steps staircase to reach the stupa on the hilltop and you can also find the superb scenery from the temple’s terrace.

Besides a variety of religious outreach programs can be enjoyed, the trip includes a visit to the Hmong Hill Tribe Village (one of the ethnic groups with their colorful traditional costumes) called “Hmong Doi Pui” located at the boundaries where travelers can discover their way of life, culture and history throughout the village as well as through their historical evidence at the museum.





# City Temples & Museum

**C**hiang Mai has had a long and independent history which has a large extent preserved Thai culture. In addition, this ancient city can be admired through fantastic scenery along the city's canals surrounded by historical and cultural heritage.

Visiting the most significant temples including “Chiang Man Temple” (the oldest temple built in the same age as Chiang Mai City), “Chedi Luang Temple” (temple with the biggest stupa), and “Phra Singh Temple” (the most beautiful architecture in northern style reflected from the chapel).

Apart from visiting temples, the city museum, “Chiang Mai City Arts & Cultural Centre”, is an interesting place which allows visitors to know and understand the origins of Chiang Mai from the past until the present day.

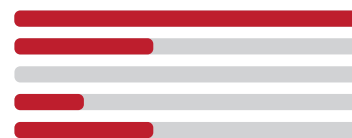

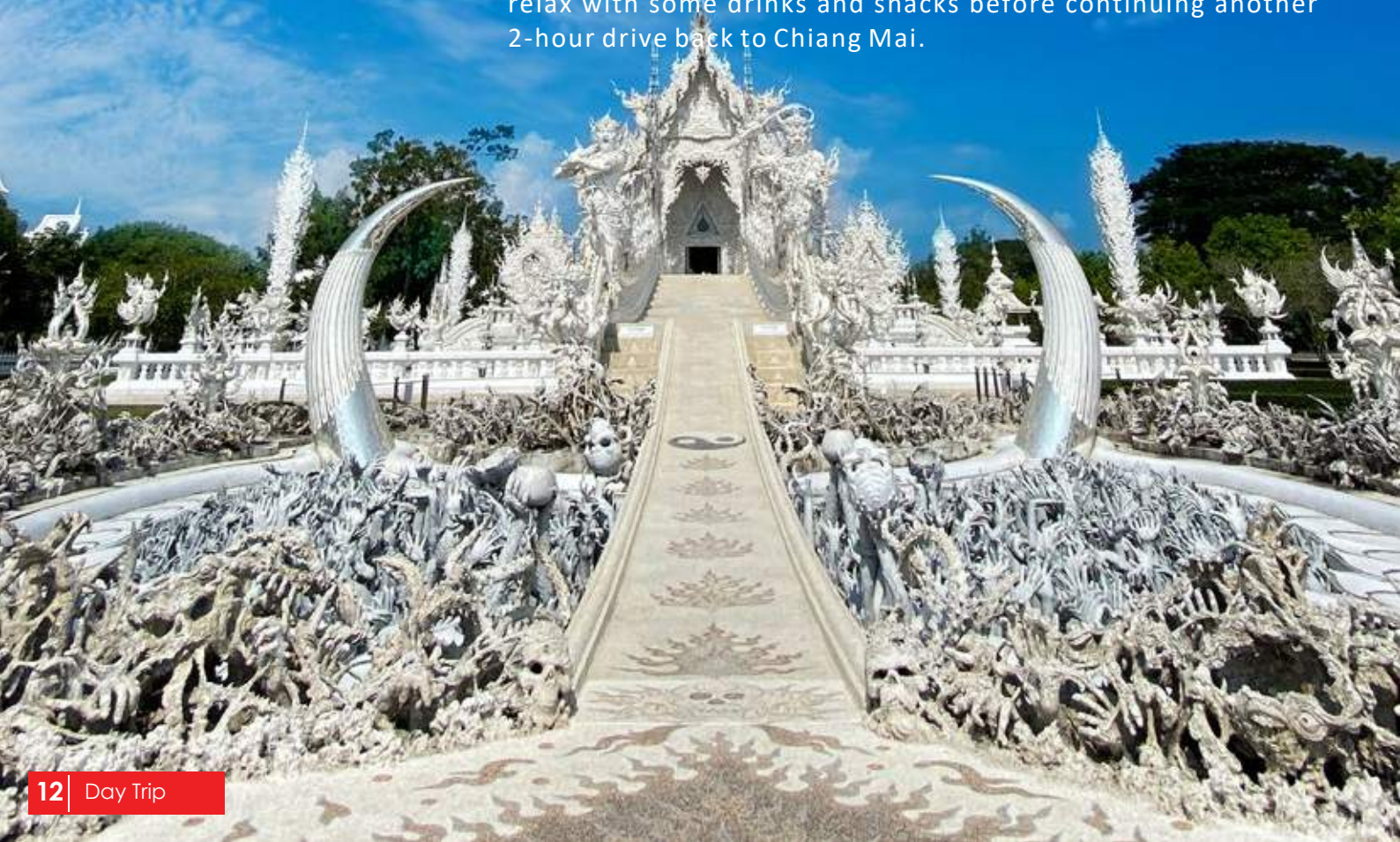
**T**his one-day trip will drive you up to the northernmost province of Thailand or also known as the land of outstanding natural beauty.

Starting with departing to Chiang Rai in the early morning and make a short break at Mae Khachan Hot Spring. Then, visit “Wat Rong Khun” or “White Temple”, a majestic temple with a full-decorated in white designed and constructed by a famous Thai Artist.

Continue to discover the history of Chiang Sean Ancient City located along Mekong River and stop by Wat Chedi Luang to explore the temple reflecting the traditional cultures in Chiang Sean Style.

After lunch, visit the “House of Opium”, a privately owned museum, with the story of the opium trade in the past. Moreover, taking the long-tailed boat along the Mekong River absorbs the panoramic view of Laos and Myanmar.

On the way back, make a short stop after a 2-hour drive to relax with some drinks and snacks before continuing another 2-hour drive back to Chiang Mai.

“ REFRESH YOUR BREATH UP WITH A SCENT OF PURE NATURE AT THE HIGHEST PEAK OF THAILAND. ”

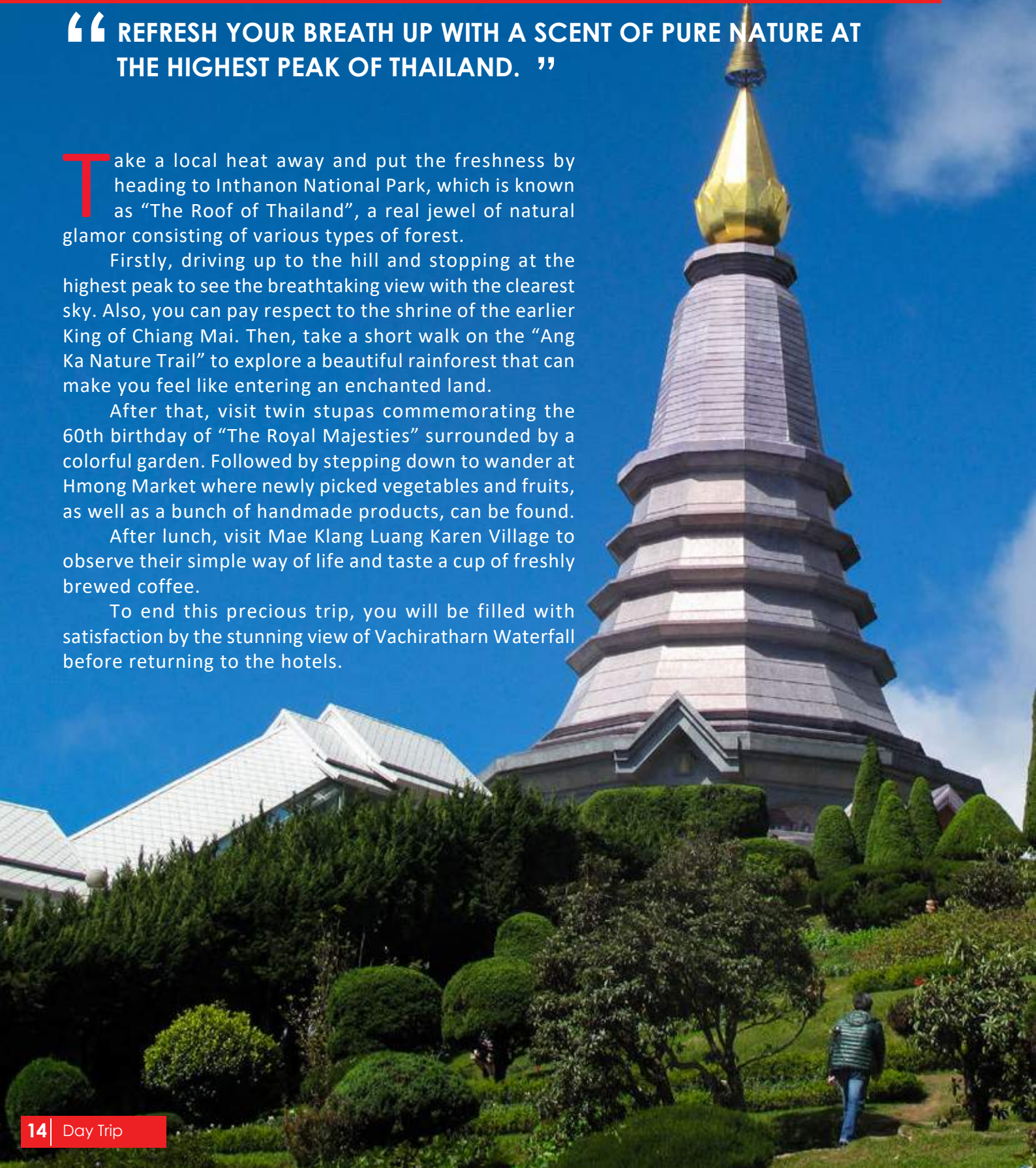

After that, visit twin stupas commemorating the 60th birthday of “The Royal Majesties” surrounded by a colorful garden. Followed by stepping down to wander at Hmong Market where newly picked vegetables and fruits, as well as a bunch of handmade products, can be found.

After lunch, visit Mae Klang Luang Karen Village to observe their simple way of life and taste a cup of freshly brewed coffee.

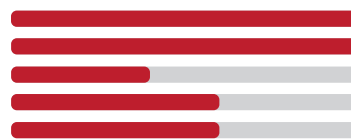

**G**et yourself ready for the exciting trek in the heart of Chiang Mai city, the trip will start with visiting Ton Payom Market a fresh local market where you can enjoy buying fruit, local food, groceries, etc.

Then, driving up to Doi Suthep – Pui National Park and stopping to visit Doi Suthep Temple, the most sacred temple surrounded by an amazing view where visitors can catch this moment with appreciation.

After that, continue to the Forestry Camp as a starting point and enjoy trekking downhill where you will walk through the mixed evergreen forest. Additionally, you will pass a beautiful small waterfall, local animals, and a variety of trees. Some parts might be quite steep and slippery but mostly on well-established natural steps along with full of fresh air.

The route ends at Monthatarn Waterfall where you can relax and appreciate the atmosphere at a valuable price.

# Eco Walk in Kew Mae Pan Nature Trail

“ALIVE FERTILE NATURAL TRAIL AND BREATHTAKING SCENERY ARE WAITING FOR EXPLORATION.”

**H**ave a great day by being a part of nature! Fresh air is waiting to welcome you to Inthanon National Park which is known as “the Roof of Thailand”. Only six months each year from November to May, a highlight of visiting this highest peak is hiking along Kew Mae Pan Nature Trail.

Drive up to the highest peak and take a short stroll along Ang Ka Nature Trail (15-20 mins). Continue by road to the starting point of Kew Mae Pan Nature Trail for the real experience by trekking in the midst of nature for 3 kilometers along Kew Mae Pan Nature Trail through the green forest, passing giant rhododendrons, small waterfalls, and beautiful streams which lead to a cliff where you can enjoy the breathtaking mountain views. After that, continue to visit twin stupas which were built to honor the king and queen for their 60th birthdays respectively.

After lunch, visit the hill tribe village where they still maintain the traditional way of life at Mae Klang Luang Village and taste some local fresh coffee. Visit the Vachiratharn Waterfall for the last stop before heading back to town.

# Soft Hike-Pha Dok Siew Trail in the Inthanon National Park

“ GO HIGHER UP TO THE HIGHEST MOUNTAIN FOR SPENDING YOUR DAYS TO EXPLORE THE INTANON NATIONAL PARK AND 2- HOURS HIKING THROUGH THE JUNGLE FOLLOWING A MOUNTAIN TRAIL ”

**2** hours drive southwest of Chiang Mai and up to mountain Inthanon National Park, where Thailand's highest mountain. The first stop at the highest spot rises to 2,565 meters above sea level, then takes a short walk around Angka Nature Trail, the rainforest rich with rare flora, animals and birds. Continue by road to visit two pagodas, built in honor of Their Majesties the King and Queen of Thailand on each of their 60th birthdays. Wander at Hmong Market sells its own products, especially vegetables and seasonal fruits.

After lunch, start a 2-hours hike to the scenic jungle along Pha Dok Siew Nature Trail. During the way, absorb a panoramic view of the rice terrace with the blue color of the sky, especially Sep - Nov. Continue hike to Karen hill tribe village to learn their way of life and upon arrival, wrap up the trip with savor the freshly ground and brewed coffee before driving back to the city and drop off at the hotel.

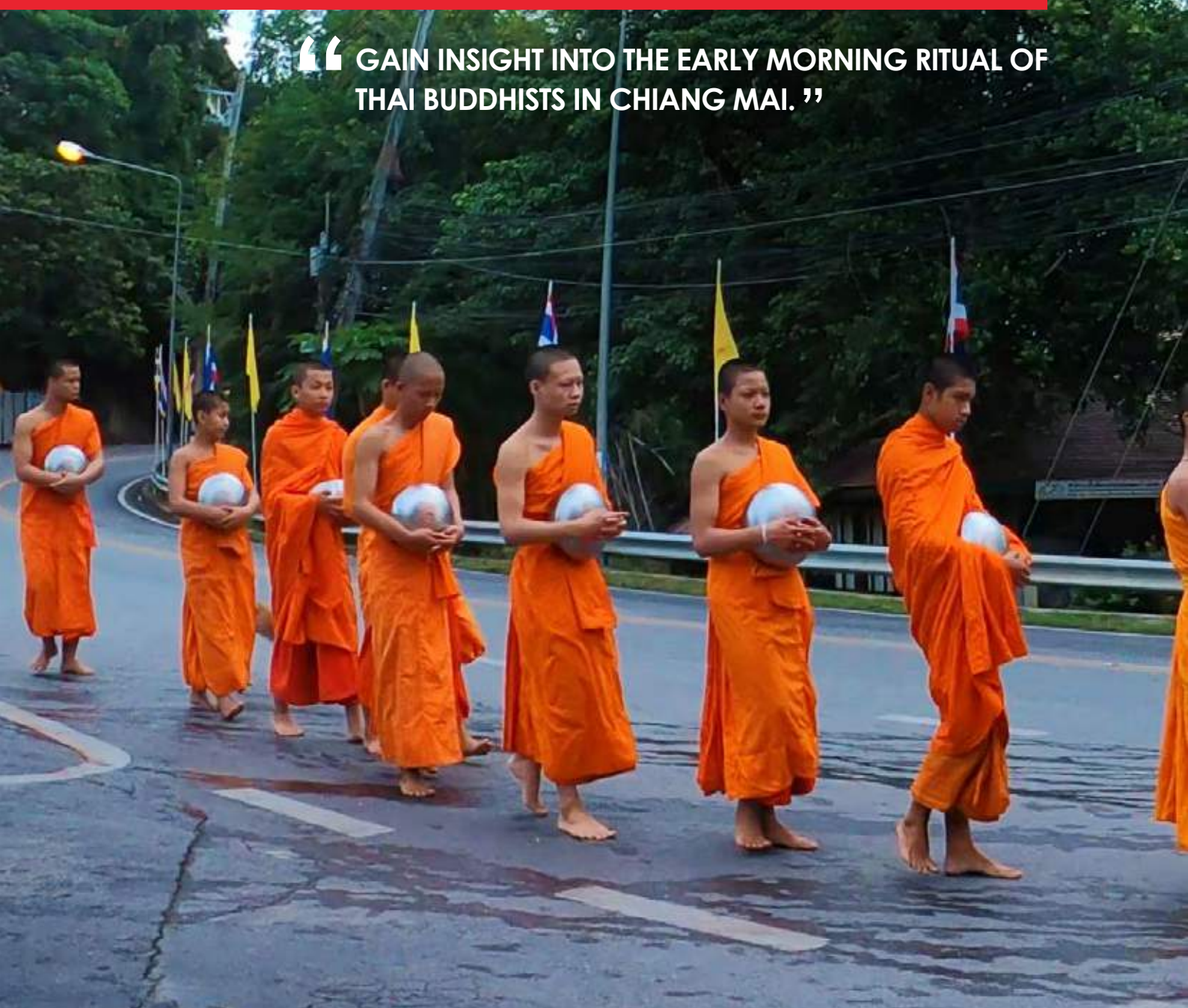
